

Location and hours


116 Peavey Circle

Take the first right (Peavey Road) after Hazeltine Blvd. Take another right on Peavey Circle. The Environmental Center will be on your left.



Items collected at NO CHARGE

Batteries (Automotive & Household) (Alkaline batteries can go in the trash)

Cartridges (Inkjet & Printer)

Clothing, Shoes, & Useable Goods Shoes should be kept separate.

Cooking Oil Vegetable, peanut, canola, olive, soybean, corn & sunflower.

Household Hazardous Waste

Home Improvement & Construction

- Latex paint
- Oil-based paint
- Paint remover/stripper/thinner
- Stain/varnish

Household Items

- Aerosol cans
- Mercury thermometers & thermostats
- Household cleaners

Yard & Garden

- Insect/roach/ant killer
- Fertilizers/pesticides/weed killer

Automotive & Recreation

- Propane tanks
- Rechargeable batteries
- Gasoline & other automotive products

Organics

All food products including meat & bones; coffee grounds & tea bags; non-recyclable paper such as pizza boxes, paper towels, paper plates, paper napkins & waxed paper containers.

Plastic Bags & Shrink Wrap Must be clean & dry.

- Boxboard (cracker, cereal, pop/beer, etc.)

- Steel & aluminum cans, foil & trays

- Plastic bottles with a 1 or 2
- Milk carton & juice boxes
