Clean up that basement, clean out the garage, and pick up the yard! The Fall Clean-up is at **no additional cost** to residents. Help keep the community free of junk and make it an even more enjoyable place to live. Following is the list of what will be picked up and what cannot be picked up:

Accepted

- All items must be small enough to be loaded by one person
- Miscellaneous clean-up debris
- Small furniture items
- Carpet (must be tied and bundled in less than four foot lengths)
- Small amounts of construction garbage
- Grills (*no gas grill propane tanks allowed*), toilets, sinks, etc.
- Clothing

Not Accepted During This Event

- **Large pieces of furniture** (call Republic Services for a special pickup at 952-941-5174)
- **Large appliances** (call Republic Services for a special pickup at 952-941-5174 or accepted at Hennepin County Drop Off Centers or Carver County Environmental Center)
- **Fluorescent light bulbs** (may be dropped off at Hennepin County Drop-Off Centers or Carver County Environmental Center)
- **Paint or other hazardous items** (may be dropped off at the Hennepin County Drop-Off Centers or Carver County Environmental Center).
- **Tires** (may be dropped off at Hennepin County Drop Off Centers or Carver County Environmental Center; fee)
- **Auto batteries**
- **Railroad ties, large piles of shingles, or large amounts of construction material** (check Yellow Pages for construction debris recycling sites)
- **Computers, TV's and related equipment** (call Republic Services for a special pickup or take to Hennepin County Drop Off Centers (Fee) or Carver County Environmental Center). Check with your local electronics retail location as some of them will accept at no cost.

Recycling will be collected on Monday, October 10.
