The City has received a large number of notifications from residents about West Point Road between County Road 19 and Fairhope Avenue. The DNR has removed the fishing regulations that have traditionally been in place at this location. Historically, fishermen have been unable to fish in this area.

RESOLUTION 14-

**A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING FISHING
ALONG WEST POINT ROAD AND AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT
OF OFFICIAL SIGNS**

WHEREAS, the Tonka Bay City Code, Subsection 710.06, Fishing, states:

No person shall use any part of or be or stand on any public street, road, highway, alley and/or other public property, for the purpose of fishing therefrom, where official signs authorized by the city of Tonka Bay prohibit said use, act or purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the files and records of the City of Tonka Bay,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tonka Bay as follows: that the placement of "No Fishing" signage along West Point Road as shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby authorized and that City staff is hereby directed to attend to the placement of said signage.


