Re: Third Reading—Amend Section 600 – Liquor

---

At the last City Council meeting the proposed amendments to Section 600 were reviewed. The amendments are shown in the redlined version of Section 600 included with your packet.

Staff is proposing the following amendment to Subd. 600.02 Subd. 12:  
*On-sale intoxicating liquor temporary liquor license sponsored by the licensee. A club or charitable, or religious or non-profit organization in existence for at least three years may be issued a temporary license for the on-sale of intoxicating liquor in connection with a social event. The license may not be for more than four consecutive days.*

The revision from the last meeting is changing the title of the license from *temporary license for the on-sale of intoxicating liquor in connection with a social event sponsored by the licensee*. The revision is in line with MN State Statutes.

Staff is proposing the following amendment to Subd. 600.09 Subd 2:  
*Consumption in Public Places*  
*No person shall consume liquor on a public highway, public park, or other public place unless the appropriate temporary liquor license has been approved by the City.*

The revision from the last meeting is changing *No person shall consume liquor on a public highway, public park, or other public place unless a special event permit has been approved by the City*. The change follows the language in tonight's Agenda Item 8B proposed amendment.
