Re: Shoreline Safety Committee Recommendation

The Shoreline Safety Committee met on 10/6/14 and provided the following recommendations to the City Council:

- 1) Restrict Parking on West Point Road and Interlachen, per highlighted areas on the attached map. Dates for the restrictions would be April 1st – June 30th. There is consistency with these dates that follow the previously posted “NO FISHING” signs by the DNR.
- 2) Public education – notification by the City Newsletter and website about times to watch for increased use County Road 19.
- 3) Intergovernmental Partnerships – continue to work with Hennepin County on signage, if necessary.

Council Action Requested:

Review, discuss and adopt the attached Resolutions prohibiting parking on West Point Road and Interlachen Lane from April 1st – June 30th.

WHEREAS, parking has resulted in safety concerns for those who live in the area and travel on West Point Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tonka Bay that based upon recommendations from City staff and their own review that the Council hereby authorizes restricting any parking along West Point Road beginning April 1st through June 30th during spawning season as shown on the attached map.




