RESOLUTION NO. 12-

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING ELECTION JUDGES FOR THE
AUGUST 14, 2012 PRIMARY ELECTION
AND THE
NOVEMBER 6, 2012 GENERAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, Minnesota Election Law requires that election judges for precincts in a municipality shall be appointed by the governing body of the municipality and that the appointments shall be made at least 25 days before the election at which the election judges will serve; and

WHEREAS, said election judges may not be the spouse, parent, child, or sibling of any election judge serving in the same precinct or of any candidate at that election, or may not be a candidate themselves in the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tonka Bay, Hennepin County, Minnesota that, pursuant to Minnesota Election Law, the following persons are appointed as election judges for the Primary Election to be held August 14, 2012 and the General Election to be held November 6, 2012:
