REGULATION OF THE SALE OF FIREWORKS
(7/31/02)

490.01 General Regulations

Subd. 1. License Required. No person, firm, corporation or franchise shall sell fireworks in the City of Tonka Bay unless a license has been obtained from the City Administrator as provided herein.

Subd. 2. License Application. The application for a license shall contain the following information: name, address, and telephone number of applicant; the address of the location where fireworks will be sold; and the type of fireworks to be sold.

490.02 Conditions of License

Subd. 1. Licenses for the sale of fireworks shall be issued subject to the following conditions:

- a. The license is non-transferable, either to another person or location.
- b. The license must be publicly displayed on the licensed premises.
- c. The premises are subject to inspection by the Fire Marshal during regular business hours.
- d. The sale of fireworks not expressly permitted by Minnesota Statutes §624.20, Subdivision 1(c) is strictly prohibited.

490.03 License Period

Licenses shall be issued for the period January 1 to December 31 of each year. The license fee shall be as designated in the City of Tonka Bay fee schedule. License fees shall not be prorated.

490.04 Revocation of License

Following written notice and an opportunity for a hearing, the City Administrator may revoke a license for violation of this Section. If a license is revoked, neither the applicant nor the licensed premises may obtain a license for twelve (12) months.

490.05 Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect after passage by the City Council and publication in the City's legal newspaper.
