Re: City Code Section Update, Section 600 Liquor – First Reading

Staff had previously identified that some minor cleanup was needed to bring Section 600 more into compliance with Minnesota State Statutes and clarify potentially conflicting language. The proposed ordinance cleans up language and makes the identified changes in our Liquor Ordinance, Section 600. The proposed changes better conform City Code with State Statutes regarding the licensing of liquor establishments. The proposed language would not change how the city handles, approves or executes liquor license applications. The proposed language also would not change eligibility requirements or application materials required.
