

RESOLUTION 19-xx

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CHAPTER VI SECTION 600 INTOXICATING LIQUORS**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the city of Tonka Bay adopted “Ordinance 2019-02 Amending Tonka Bay City Ordinance Code Chapter VI Section 600 Intoxicating Liquors”; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has prepared a summary of ordinance 2019-02 which states that the purpose is to cite appropriate Minnesota State Statutes, and clarify potentially conflicting language; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota state law allows the City Council to direct staff by a four-fifths vote that only the title of the ordinance and a summary be published; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota state law allows publication by title and summary in the case of lengthy ordinances or those containing charts or maps; and

WHEREAS, the verbatim text of the ordinance is several pages, is cumbersome, and the expense of publication of the complete text is not justified; and

WHEREAS, the following summary clearly informs the public of the intent and effect of the ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Tonka Bay, Hennepin County, Minnesota, that the following summary is hereby approved for official publication:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TONKA BAY ORDINANCE CODE

On April 23rd, 2019 the Tonka Bay City Council adopted an ordinance designated as Ordinance No. 2019-02, the title of which is stated above. The purpose of the ordinance is to amend Section 600 Intoxicating Liquors to cite appropriate Minnesota State states and clarify potentially conflicting language. A full copy of the ordinance is available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk during normal business hours.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that only the title and summary of the ordinance be published; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the text of the summary is hereby approved.
