

SECTION 100 CITY CODE

100.01 CITY CODE; HOW CITED

This codification of the ordinances of the City of Tonka Bay shall be cited and known as "The Tonka Bay City Code."

100.02 CITATION; REFERENCE AND NUMBERING SYSTEM

Each section number of this code consists of two component parts separated by a decimal. The first digit or first two digits of the number if the number has four digits before the decimal point refers to the chapter number. The two digits immediately preceding the decimal point refers to the section number. The two digits following the decimal point refer to subsections. Subdivisions will be denominated as such.

100.03 AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONS

Ordinances proposing additions or amendments to the Code shall be assigned appropriate Code numbers and shall be incorporated into the Code as of their effective date. Reference or citation to the Code shall be deemed to include such amendments and additions. When an ordinance is integrated into the Code, there may be omitted from the ordinance the title, enacting clause, section numbers, definitions of terms identical to those contained in this code, the clause indicating date of adoption, and validating signatures and dates. In integrating ordinances into the Code the City Administrator, in cooperation with the City Attorney, may correct obvious grammatical, punctuation, and spelling errors, and perform like actions to insure a uniform and accurate code of ordinances without, however, altering the meaning of the ordinance enacted.

100.04 TITLES, HEADINGS AND CROSS REFERENCES

Chapter, section, subdivision and other titles shall not be considered part of the subject matter of this code but are intended only for the convenience of the reader, and shall not necessarily be considered as comprehensive titles. The cross reference indexing system shall not be considered part of the subject matter of this code but is intended only to facilitate access to code sections.

100.05 Copies of the Tonka Bay City Code shall be kept in the office of the City Administrator for public inspection. Copies may be purchased for a reasonable charge as determined by the City Council.
