

SECTION 760
STORAGE OF MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL

760.01 NO STORAGE IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS

No person, firm or corporation shall store within the City's residential districts, any gasoline or diesel fuel or Class I fuels which shall include all fuels which have a point below 100 degrees Fahrenheit in any container or tank or in any manner in an amount exceeding 15 gallons. All said fuels so legally stored shall be in approved containers.

760.02 EXEMPTIONS AND EXCEPTIONS

Subd. 1 Business Purposes

Businesses storing motor vehicle fuel for usual business purposes on property zoned commercial or on property zoned residential where the business is conducted pursuant to an existing permit, shall be exempt from these regulations.

Subd. 2 Motor Vehicles and Boats

These regulations shall not apply to tanks which are attached to or are an integral part of any motorized vehicles or boats.

Subd. 3 Tanks in existence prior to March 25, 1980

Storage tanks in existence as of March 25, 1980 meeting all State fire, safety and environmental regulations now in force or as hereafter amended, shall be allowed to continue in use only so long as said tanks remain in good repair and meet all State fire, safety and environmental regulations. All other fuel storage tanks including, but not limited to, home heating fuel tanks which are abandoned or no longer in use on or after said March 25, 1980, shall at the owner's option, either be removed or filled with sand or other earthen material within ninety (90) days of such abandonment or disuse.

760.03 PENALTY

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
