

SECTION 900 MOTOR VEHICLES

900.01 DEFINITIONS

Subd. 1 Motor Vehicle “Motor Vehicle” shall mean every vehicle defined as a “Motor Vehicle” by Minnesota Statutes Section 169.01 subd. 3 as periodically amended. The definition of motor vehicle contained in Minnesota Statutes Section 169.01 subd. 3 is hereby incorporated by reference and is to be considered a part of this code as if set out fully herein.

900.02 EVERY VEHICLE SHALL BE REGISTERED

Every motor vehicle used, operated or stopped on any street, highway, or roadway within the City of Tonka Bay shall be registered in compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 168, as periodically amended. No person shall drive, operate, or park a motor vehicle on any street, highway, or roadway within the City of Tonka Bay unless said motor vehicle shall be registered in compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 168, as periodically amended.

900.03 DRIVER’S LICENSE REQUIRED

No person shall drive or operate a motor vehicle upon any street, highway, or roadway within the City of Tonka Bay without having in his possession, as required by the laws of the State of Minnesota, Chapter 171, as periodically amended, a valid driver’s license or chauffeur’s license.

Subd. 1 No person shall drive or operate a motor vehicle belonging to another without the owner’s consent.

900.04 EXHIBITION DRIVING

No person shall operate any motor vehicle with unnecessary exhibition of speed on any public or private way within the city limits. Prima facie evidence of such unnecessary exhibition of speed shall be any or all of the following:

- a. Unreasonable squealing or screeching sounds emitted by the tires
- b. The throwing of sand or gravel by the tires of the vehicle
- c. Unreasonable skid, sway or slide upon acceleration or stopping

900.05 PENALTY

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
