

906.01 FIRE LANES

Subd. 1. All fire lanes in the City shall be located, identified, and the use thereof restricted to one of the following classifications. All fire lanes are to provide lake access to the public, subject to the restrictions contained herein.

- a. Class I shall only be used for pedestrian access to the lake, fishing from shore, launching canoes, and other small boats not requiring a trailer.
- b. Class II shall only be used for all the activities as designated in Class I as well as snowmobile access during the winter, subject to the regulations of Section 905 of the City Code.*
- c. Class III shall only be used for the following: fishing from shore, winter vehicular access to the lake by vehicles not exceeding 10,000 pounds in weight, launching and retrieving of watercraft not exceeding twenty-seven feet (27') in length or exceeding ten thousand pounds (10,000) in weight. For purposes of this subdivision, length shall mean the horizontal measurement from the foremost to the aftermost points of the watercraft, including all equipment and attachments in their normal operation positions.
- d. Class IV 12-Hill (inaccessible) shall only be used for winter vehicular traffic access to the lake.

Subd. 2. The following fire lanes shall be classified as follows:

- a. Class I. 1-Crescent, 11-Pearl, 14-North Channel, 15-South Channel, 17- North Manitou, 2-Lake Place, 4-West Point, 6-North Sunrise, 7-South Sunrise, 9-Aspen, 10-Hazel, 16-Woodlawn, 19-Apgar, 20-North Brentwood, 21-South Brentwood.
- b. Class II. 3-Interlachen, 8-South Waseca, 13-Woodpecker*, 18-Bay*.

* - Class II fire lanes marked with an asterisk may also be used for winter vehicular access subject to the restrictions in Subdivision 1, paragraph c above, as well as the hours of operation imposed in Subdivision 4 below.

- c. Class III. 5-North Waseca.
- d. Class IV. 12-Hill (inaccessible)

Subd. 3. Unless permitted by the City in writing, no parking, private landscaping, or placement, erection, or encroachment of any structure shall be allowed within any fire lanes.

Subd. 4. No person shall operate any motor vehicle upon any fire lane between the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

Subd. 5. Any person who shall violate this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
